IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT OUR SPECIAL JUNE MEETING: For several years, Jim and Gayle Steed have graciously hosted TSMRI members and their spouses for a good old-fashioned get-together and semi-social event. This year is no exception...but it's going to be a little different this time with a very exclusive opportunity to visit the Misty Mountain Railroad. Here are the details:

DIRECTIONS: Cabin, Jim & Gayle Steed, 156 Arkaqua View, Blairsville, Ga. 30512 Cell [706 835 7129](tel:7068357129). Starting at the old Courthouse Square, downtown Blairsville, on US 19/129,,,,Go south on US 19/129 (toward Vogel State Park) for 2 1/2 miles. Turn left on Towncreek School Rd. (Note gas/convenience/Amish store on left). Then go 2 1/2 miles and turn left (just over hill) on Lower Trackrock Rd. (Note black fence and cattle farm on left,, comes up fast). Then go 4/10ths mile and turn right on Pineridge Rd. Then go 2/10ths of a mile and turn right on

Everetts View (Cheyenne Meadow Subdivision) a gravel Road. Go to back of Subdivision, about 3/10ths of a mile, and turn left on Arkaqua View (our road). Continue through split rail fencing to end of road, cul-de-sac, and park. You have arrived. Welcome!

Parking all around cul-de-sac, and on each side of road. May want to angle or head-in park to make room for everyone parking. Walk in driveway, enter left side of Cabin/porch/walkway to back side. Enjoy large back porch, creek, long range view of Blood Mountain looking East. Drive time from Blueridge approximately 35 minutes. From Murphy apx. 30 minutes. From the Courthouse Square/Blairsville approximately 10 minutes. **Arrive 5:30 pm.** **Bring nothing but a good appetite and attitude.**

Directions to Misty Mountain RR, Misty Mountain Lane. (Town creek School Rd.) Pia Kluth, owner, Charles Griffin's daughter-in-law. mistymountainmodelrailroad.com **Open 4:30 - 5:30 pm**, \$5 donation. (Pia will join us for dinner at Cabin.) Same as above,,,South out of Blairsville on US 19/129 for 2 1/2 miles and turn left on Town Creek School Rd. Go 3 1/2 miles out Towncreek School Rd. (One mile past Lower Trackrock Rd. on left). See Misty Mountain Model RR sign on right. Turn right in driveway and follow sign up the hill to parking in rear. For back to Jim & Gayle's Cabin, turn left out of driveway and go back the way you came on Towncreek School Rd. (one mile) to Lower Trackrock Rd. on right, and turn right. Follow directions above on Lower Trackrock Rd. Note: Do not guarantee GPS, as in some cases it just does not get you there in these hills.
